RE: Spring 2021 Panther Success Grant Disbursement

In a Special Campus Announcement on January 14, I announced that upon careful review, the University was able to expand the Panther Success Grant (PSG) to include freshmen and sophomores with shortfalls in personal finances or financial aid. Funds were then disbursed on January 19 to students with unpaid balances that might prevent their progress or enrollment for the spring semester.

This week, we will disburse additional grants to undergraduate students who are enrolled in the spring 2021 semester. To be eligible for these funds, students must be enrolled and did not receive the full cost of attendance in their financial aid award. There is no need to apply; students will receive a communication if a grant is applied to their account. We will first focus on those with unpaid balances after which we will focus on opportunities to reduce eligible students' loan amounts.

The maximum grant will be \$2,000 for the semester and the award is applied directly to the student's account.
