Over the weekend, through our campus COVID-19 case management process, it was reported that two individuals who tested positive for COVID-19 attended the President's holiday social. Therefore, we are asking all individuals who attended the social to do the following:

- If you test positive for COVID-19, self-report using the appropriate self-reporting form.
