Re: Spring 2022 COVID Update

Greetings Panthers! Once again, we find ourselves returning to campus with rising COVID cases and increased concerns regarding how to stay safe. Therefore, please use this as a brief update and use [www.pvamu.edu/coronavirus](http://www.pvamu.edu/coronavirus) for more detailed information.

### **Isolation & Quarantine**

**Please note the COVID isolation/quarantine time frame has been reduced to seven (7) days starting February 1, 2022.** This will NOT be retroactively applied and would apply to individuals who test positive or come in contact with a confirmed positive on campus on or after February 1, 2022.

### **Reporting Cases & Contacts**

Use the self-reporting forms ([www.pvamu.edu/coronavirus/selfreporting](http://www.pvamu.edu/coronavirus/selfreporting)) to report positive test results from on-campus and off-campus facilities.

**Students** – you **must report within 48 hours** of notification to be included on the Academic Affairs faculty notification list. Once you have completed isolation/quarantine, schedule a COVID Clearance appointment.

**Employees** – you are **required to communicate with your supervisor** regarding remote work options. Once you have completed isolation/quarantine, complete the Employee COVID Clearance Form.

### **REPORT POSITIVE CASES & ON CAMPUS CONTACT WITH A POSITIVE CASE ONLY.**

To be compliant with state laws prohibiting contact tracing, the COVID Hotline will only engage in case management for students and employees who test positive or are exposed by an on-campus COVID positive case.
