  - Departmental reviews ascertained that candidates required a structured clinical model and improved TExES practice results prior to entering student teaching. Candidates are now required to pass the practice exam with a minimum of 80%.
  
2. **Based on data (surveys, interviews, focus groups, et cetera), what do you know about student learning and/or service delivery for this cycle? Were the changes successful? Summarize your Forms A-1s and / or A-2s.**
  - Student Learning: Based on an overview of program requirements and an assessment of program rigor, the following changes were made:
    - Faculty within the department reviewed state and national requirements for emerging teacher education trends.
  - Service Delivery: Analysis of candidate feedback indicated that candidates were not always aware of the program completion requirements.
  
3. **Based on question # 2 above (surveys, interviews, focus groups, et cetera), what will you do to improve student learning and / or service delivery during the next cycle? Include outcomes, strategies, measure(s), targets, and cycle.**

- Student Learning: Implementation of mandatory clinical model for all teacher candidates; implementation of additional program rigor incorporating a mandatory passage rate of 80-85% on the practice PPR examination.
- Service Delivery: Distribution of degree plan to all candidates.
