1. Organization	__Target(3) Candidate information is organized in a logical, interesting sequence which audience can follow consistently.	__Acceptable(2) Candidate informati on organized in logical sequence which audience can follow.	__Unacceptable(0-1) Audience has difficulty following presentation because candidate jumps around.
2. Subject Knowledge	__Target(3) Candidate presents information in logical, interesting sequence which audience can follow.	__Acceptable(2) Candidate presents information in logical sequence which audience can follow.	__Unacceptable(0-1) Candidate is uncomfortable with information and is able to answer only rudimentary questions.

Audience members have difficulty hearing presentation.</p>
5. Eye Contact	__Target(3) <p>Candidate maintains eye contact with audience, seldom returning to notes.</p>	__Acceptable(2) <p>Candidate maintains eye contact most of the time but frequently returns to notes.</p>	__Unacceptable(0-1) <p>Candidate reads all of report with no eye contact.</p>
