WHITES-ONLY KENLAKE PARK. THIS IS THAT STORY.)

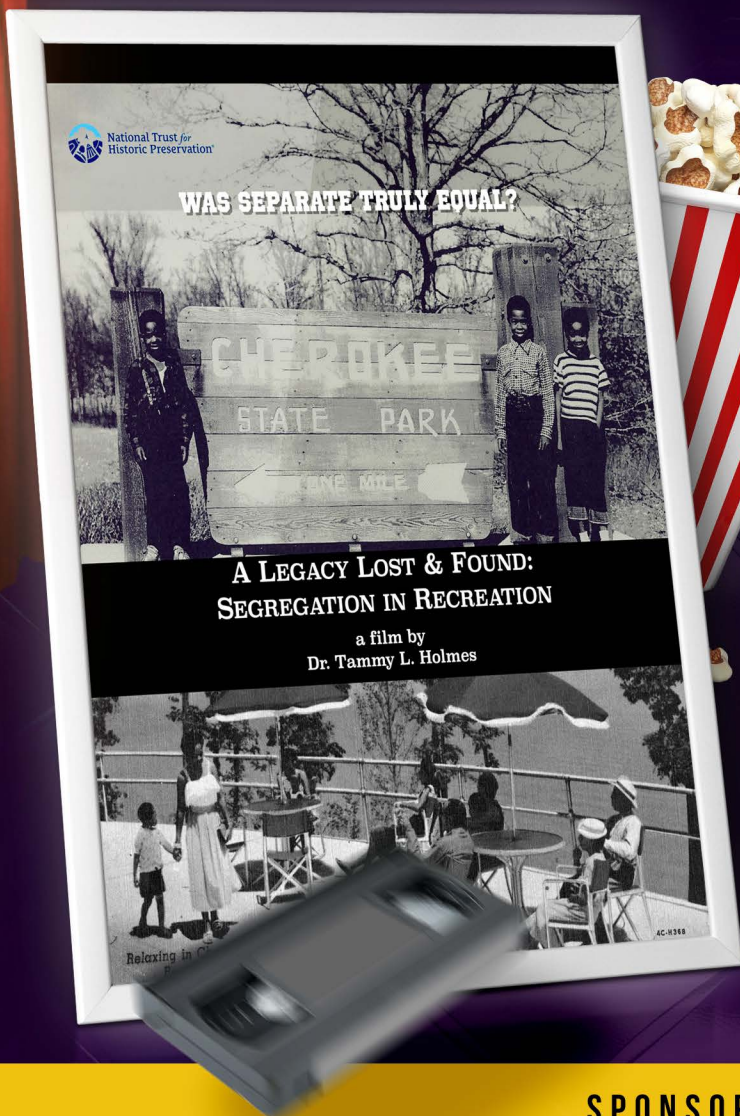
