
Viewing Transfer and Institutional Credit

A summary of all institutional credit earned at PVAMU in order by semester taken and then by CRN.




It is recommended that you leave the Term field blank and click Next Block to view the student information. Scroll through information using the scroll bar on the right hand side of the form.

SHATERM


This form provides current standing and term GPA detail for transfer and institutional courses.

The course level for the student must be selected.


It is recommended that the Start Term field be left blank.

Select the Term GPA and Course Detail Information to view transfer and institutional courses by term.




Use the scroll bar on the right hand side of the form to view additional terms.

Grading Explanation

- Transfer Courses will have a grade of TA, TB, or TC. Transfer grades are counted in attempted hours and earned hours but are not calculated in the GPA hours, Quality Points or the GPA.
- Grades beginning with an ^ are grades for developmental courses that are no longer counted in the GPA hours, Quality Points or the GPA. Their credit is still reflected only in the Attempted Hours. This transaction normally occurs when the student has applied for graduation but may also be seen when developmental courses have been repeated.
- Grades beginning with a * are grades for courses which will display on the transcript but the course and grade will not count any academic statistics. Normally seen in graduate certification programs.
- Repeated courses which are excluded from the academic statistics but still displayed on the transcript will have an 'E' in the repeat field. PVAMU's current repeat policy is that the last grade earned is the grade counted in the academic statistics.

Transfer Courses


Transfer courses which have a PVAMU equivalent will display as the PVAMU course information. Transfer courses with no equivalent with display with a GENL value for the course and the subject value may be anywhere from 0000-4999. The Registration team is working with the Transfer Equivalency team to set up other GENL indicators such as GBUS – General Business or GENG – Engineering to work with the CAPP (degree audit) process in Banner.



Transfer credit on SHATERM displays by the Transfer Institution Number. To see the name of the transfer institution, use the F5 button to display the Direct Access block



On SHATRNS tab over to the Transfer Institution Number field and use the LOV button to display the transfer institutions.



Click the X to exit from SHQTRIT and SHATRNS to return to SHATERM.

It is recommended that Banner Panthertracks is the best source to view the academic transcript. All that is required for this is the Student name or ID.
