Can I access articles written by nurses?

Yes! CINAHL is the most popular database that allows you to limit your search specifically to sources written by nurses. To do this, you'd perform an advanced search and check the "Author is Nurse" box. Contact me for a tutorial! [CINAHL](#)



What is the difference between the TMC Library Card application and OpenAthens application?

The TMC Library Card application allows members to visit the library and utilize services once approved. The OpenAthens application allows members to utilize the TMC Library's digital materials like online articles, eBooks, and databases. How do I request an interlibrary loan?

If you need materials that are not currently available, you may fill out an interlibrary loan request form. When filling out the form, ensure you include as much publication information as possible about the source. For instance, noting volume and issue numbers for journal articles.

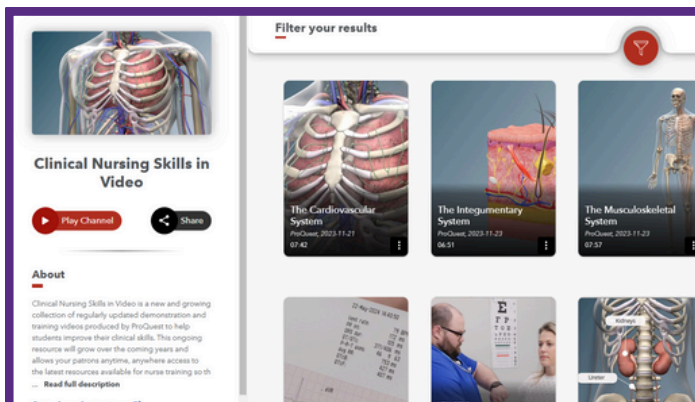
Where can I find online nursing films?

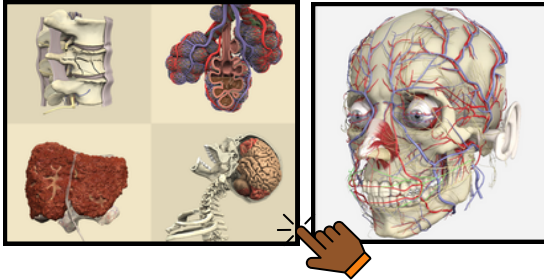
