

Important Nursing
Related Databases:



CINAHL—(Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature) Collection of nursing and allied health related journals. Your number one source when collecting articles for your research.



PubMed—collection of more than 24 million citations related to the medical field. Access PubMed through TMC and it will link to articles that are available through TMC subscribed databases.



Nursing Reference Center—evidence based resource designed for nurses to help them answer patients' questions.



Stat!Ref—Collection of nursing related ebooks.



Ref Works—online tool that creates bibliographies. You can import article information from databases like CINAHL and the tool will automatically create bibliographies using many citation formats including APA.

Access:

To sign up for Online Access to the TMC Library, please go to this link and fill out the form.

Make sure that you select the correct PVAMU classification.

TMC Inter Library Loan:

The first time you need an article or a book that the TMC library does not own, you will need to create an ILL account. You can do so here: <http://illiadw.library.tmc.edu/>. It is very important that you use your student PVAMU email address for this. TMC Library provides free ILL service to their patrons, and the system recognizes you by your school email address. For "Preferred article delivery method" choose "Mail to address," then for "Preferred electronic delivery if possible (PDF file via Web)," also choose YES. Your articles will be sent to you via your email in a pdf format. The Library will provide at no cost to our users, 5 requests per day and up to **35 each semester**. Additional requests during the semester will be filled for \$5.00 each.

Getting a Library Card:
