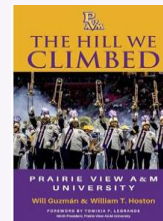

Tripti Sinha

Tripti Sinha is the President and Chief Executive Officer of Internet2, where she champions the organization's core mission of enabling U.S. higher education and research institutions to collaborate on mission-critical technology services. Sinha is a leader in information technology, operations, governance, and policy, with a career spanning more than three decades dedicated to advancing cyberinfrastructure and internet technologies in research and education. Sinha held leadership roles at the University of Maryland: Assistant Vice President and Chief Technology Officer within the Division of Information Technology, and Executive Director of the Mid-Atlantic Crossroads (MAX), a regional research and education network. In these roles, she supported advanced, high-performance networking and research technologies including GPU compute infrastructure optimized for AI workloads. She was actively involved in investigating evolving quantum networking technologies. Sinha is internationally recognized for her leadership in internet governance, particularly in the stewardship of the technical foundations of the global internet's unique identifier systems and collaboration across related sectors.
