Please complete the following information. We are required by law to obtain this information from you. You are required by law to provide your correct Social Security Number or Employer Identification Number to us. If you do not provide us with this information, your payments may be subject to 28% federal income tax backup withholding. Also, if you do not provide us with this information, you may be subject to a \$50 penalty imposed by the Internal Revenue Service under section 6723.

Federal Law on backup withholding preempts any state or local law remedies, such as any right to a mechanic's lien.
