## What is Title IX?

Congress enacted Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972 to prohibit sex discrimination in any educational program or activity. The Act applies to both public and private institutions that receive federal funds.

**Sexual Harassment** includes, but is not limited to:

- Sexual assault (i.e. sexual activity without consent)
- Dating or Domestic Violence (DV)
- Sexual exploitation
- Stalking

## What is Consent?

Consent is a clear, voluntary and ongoing agreement to sexual activity. If a person is incapacitated due to drugs, alcohol or other reasons, they can not give consent.
